



transPIER

The TransPIER is an attempt to reveal a different side of the world around us. As we descend, there is a point at which the eye crosses the threshold between air and water, between the world we inhabit and the unknown that surrounds us. The city becomes a watery reflection through the waves over our heads. The end of the pier is side-lit by a structural tube with a ladder up to the surface. A microphone in the water catches the
